5. Terms of Sale

I understand that under 49 CFR 591.7(c) the importer of the subject vehicle may not sell, or transfer possession of or title to, the vehicle except under such terms and conditions that NHTSA may establish.

If NHTSA agrees to permit sale of the vehicle, I agree to abide by each of the following terms until the vehicle is 25 years old:

- To create, maintain, and make available at reasonable times for review or copying by NHTSA the following records:
 - a. Title to the vehicle.
 - b. A copy of the HS-7 Declaration Form and other relevant importation documents for the vehicle.
 - c. A log indicating all locations where the vehicle is shown or displayed, including a description of any event, event sponsor, and method used to transport the vehicle to and from the event. I agree that the log will cover the entire exemption period and give the mileage of the vehicle for each event.
 - d. Current insurance policy in the name of the owner limiting use of the vehicle to 2,500 miles per year.
- 2. To allow inspection upon request to verify that the accumulated mileage of the vehicle is not more than 2,500 miles in any 12-month period.
- To not sell, or transfer possession of, or title to, the vehicle, except under such terms and conditions as the Administrator may authorize in writing.
- 4. To not register the vehicle for use on the public roads.

OR

If the vehicle is registered for use on the public roads, to not accumulate more than 2,500 miles on the vehicle in any 12-month period.
